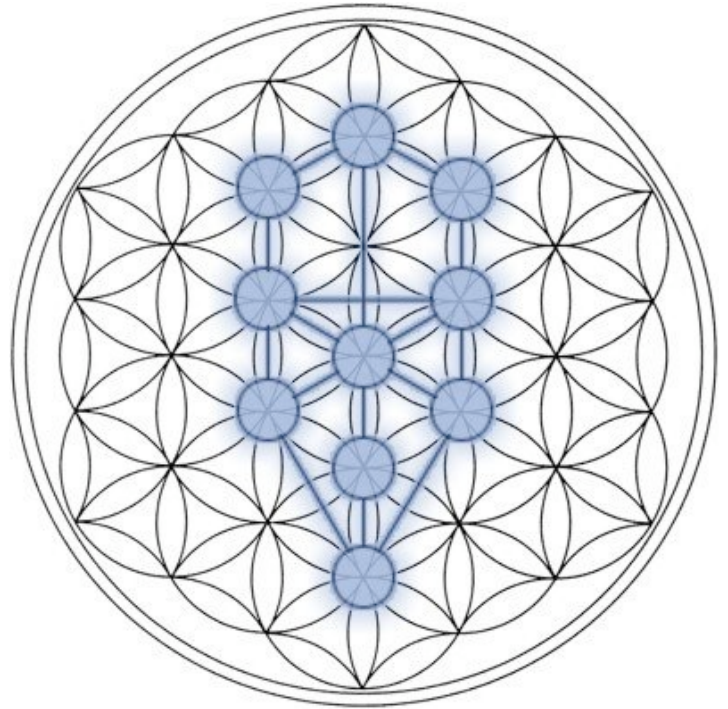


**Living Kabbalah: An Introduction to Non-dual Living.
